

Florida Presbytery Summer Camp Dress and Conduct Standards

PURPOSE: Paul shared this Biblical guideline with Timothy, “Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith and in purity.” (1 Timothy 4:12)

It is not our purpose to pass judgment on individuals, families, or local churches, but rather to set a standard to govern the appearance and conduct of all young men and ladies while at the Florida Presbytery Summer Camp.

CONDUCT: Whether in Teaching sessions, participating in sports, or any other type of activity, Christ-like conduct is required at all times.

NOT PERMITTED: Inappropriate language, jokes or gestures; the use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco in any form; or the use of any un-prescribed drugs is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated.

Appearance

Shirts

Shirts must be in good condition (no inappropriate holes, tears, stains, or objectionable words or pictures, etc.).

Must be modest (length must cover stomach and back while bending over or raising hands; must be loose fitting; no immodest necklines, front or back).

Any sleeveless shirt must cover under garments (including bra straps)

Pants/Shorts

Should be mid-thigh in length.

All must be modest and in good condition (no inappropriate rips or holes, and covering underwear at all times). and should be no shorter than mid thigh.

Leggings may not be worn as pants but may be worn under shorts that are atleast mid thigh.

Shoes

Flipflops/Slides are needed for Pool/shower time. Closed toed shoes are required for most activities.

Swimwear

Swimsuits are to be modest (at the discretion of the Lead counselors for boys and girls) and a shirt is required to be worn.

Specific to women

Skirts/dresses if worn must touch the middle of the knee (including slits). Skirts/dresses shorter than mid knee may be worn if they are atleast mid-thigh and have leggings worn underneath.
